1. When traveling from home, parents/guardians are responsible for the safety of their children until they arrive at school and return home from school. The school/district is not liable for any injuries that result from a child walking or riding their bicycle to/from school.
2. All bikers must have helmets to participate in the program. Failure to wear a helmet will result in dismissal from the program.
3. Bikes must be parked in the bike rack or designated bike parking area once at school.
4. Parents must check their children's bikes for safety before starting the program and then ensure proper working order throughout the school year.
5. Parents will assume full responsibility and liability for their student's conduct and safety. The school district cannot legally assume any responsibility or liability in connection with a child's bicycle if it becomes lost, stolen or damaged. In addition, parents/guardians release the Dearborn Public Schools, it's employees, trustees and officers from any and all liability resulting from any injuries, which may occur to my child as a result of his/her riding a bicycle or walking to school.
