A threatening note was found by a student in their locker. The note made a threat to four students. We immediately called in the Dearborn Police to help us investigate and assess the situation. The families of the involved students have been notified, and the police have deemed our school safe. Our children's safety is our ultimate priority. We also always have our team on hand to assist with any concerns this brings our students indirectly, as our student's emotional well-being is always a priority for us as well.

We are very grateful for our strong partnership with the Dearborn Police Department and our school resource officer program, as it assisted us in acting swiftly and appropriately to this situation.
